## REMEMBERING THE INVALUABLE CONTRIBUTION AND LEGACY OF DR. BEN ARMSTRONG

- WHEREAS** Dr. Ben Armstrong passed from this world and into the presence of his Lord and Savior in December of 2010; and
- WHEREAS** Dr. Armstrong was a faithful minister of the Gospel, the recipient of several advanced degrees, a theological teacher, an author, a radio broadcaster, and the 1998 inductee into NRB's Hall of Fame; and
- WHEREAS** Dr. Armstrong served as the administrative head of National Religious Broadcasters for twenty three years, starting in 1966; and
- WHEREAS** during those critical years, it was Dr. Armstrong's vision, dedication, and prayerful commitment to the Lord that led NRB from a fledgling organization operating out of a small room in his home, with only a part-time secretary, to an effective and professional national organization which now enjoys a significant presence on Capitol Hill; and
- WHEREAS** President Ronald Reagan recognized Dr. Armstrong's leadership, in 1986, by voicing a personal tribute and praising him "for being the patriot that you are, the man of God that you are, my thanks; May He bless you and Ruth as you start your next twenty years;" and therefore be it
- RESOLVED** that National Religious Broadcasters honors the stellar contribution, the personal sacrifice, and the leadership vision of Dr. Ben Armstrong, by dedicating our national convention, NRB 2011, to his memory; and be it further
- RESOLVED** that the Capitol Hill Office of the NRB will henceforth be designated as the Ben Armstrong Center for Media Freedom.
